Report from the Zero Carbon Group

Two meetings of the Net Zero Carbon group, set up at the TANN AGM on the 13th of November, were held on 13th January and 23rd February.



Initially proposed for the TANN area alone, it has attracted interest from people in neighbouring areas with similar 'hard-to-heat' housing and Conservation Area restrictions, and is now a more open group.

Focussing on the built environment, it aims to promote retrofit, zero carbon, new-build and local renewable energy generation, as part of the national objective to make buildings zero net carbon by 2050. Guided by Passivhaus principles, it will support both whole-house solutions and intelligent partial measures that can be added to later. The experiences of other towns like the <https://carbon.coop/portfolio/people-powered-retrofit/> project in Manchester will be assessed.

The next meeting will be held at 7pm on Sunday 15th March at the Ullet Road Eco Offices, 125a Ullet Road, L17 2AB (door on right). Please come early if you want a cup of tea, so we can make a prompt start.
